**Care and Maintenance**

<b>Sweep or Vacuum</b>	Sweep or vacuum regularly ( <b>Tile</b> )
<b>Spills</b>	tend spills asap as spills may discolor grout.
<b>Wash</b>	Wash tiles with clean water, if using soap or mild detergent make sure it is pH balanced
<b>No Acid Or Bleach</b>	NEVER use any cleaners that contain acid. Acidic or bleach-based products may strip pigment from grout and will cause sanded grouts to deteriorate.



### Natural Stone

<b>Dust mop</b>	Rather than using regular broom to sweep up dirt and debris, use a dust mop on your marble floors
<b>Vacuum</b>	Vacuum with care. Make sure wheels are intact, and no rough edges will scratch your floors
<b>To clean</b>	Use pH neutral soap. Acidic substances can corrode marble. Avoid harsh cleaners with acid, lemon or vinegar. Use a soft cloth. Don't use rough/scrubby sponges. Instead use a gentle cloth.
<b>Prevent Water Stains</b>	Remove Standing Water. To prevent water spots penetrating on your marble make sure to wring out the mop so it doesn't slosh excess water onto your floor.



<b>Avoid</b>	Never use bleach, vinegar, or lemon juice as there can etch and eventually damage the stone's surface. Never apply wax or acrylics. This will damage the stone
<b>Spills</b>	Tend spill quickly. Sealer does not prevent 100% of damage due to spills.
<b>To clean</b>	Wash tiles with clean water, if using soap or mild detergent make sure it is pH balanced. It is recommended to only use cleaners specifically designed for cleaning natural stone. Sweep or vacuum your floors regularly, dirt and dust can scratch the surface.
<b>No Acid Or Bleach</b>	NEVER use any cleaners that contain acid. Acidic or bleach-based products may strip pigment from grout and will cause sanded grouts to deteriorate.

<b>Cleaning Products</b>	Do not use vinyl or tile cleaning products on wood floors. Self polishing acrylic waxes cause wood to become slippery and appear dull quickly.
<b>Do not wet</b>	Do not wet-mop or steam mop a wood floor. Water and steam can dull the finish and even damage the wood.
<b>No over-wax</b>	Do not over-wax a wood floor. If wax floor dulls, try buffing instead.
<b>Protect from Furniture</b>	Put stick-on felt protectors under furniture legs to prevent scuffing and scratching.
<b>Winter</b>	Use a humidifier throughout the winter months to minimize gaps. ( <b>Hardwood</b> )



### Hardwood



<b>Sweep or vacuum</b>	Sweep or vacuum regularly.
